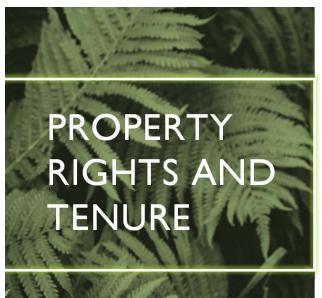
- Problem statement: historic discrimination and inequality
