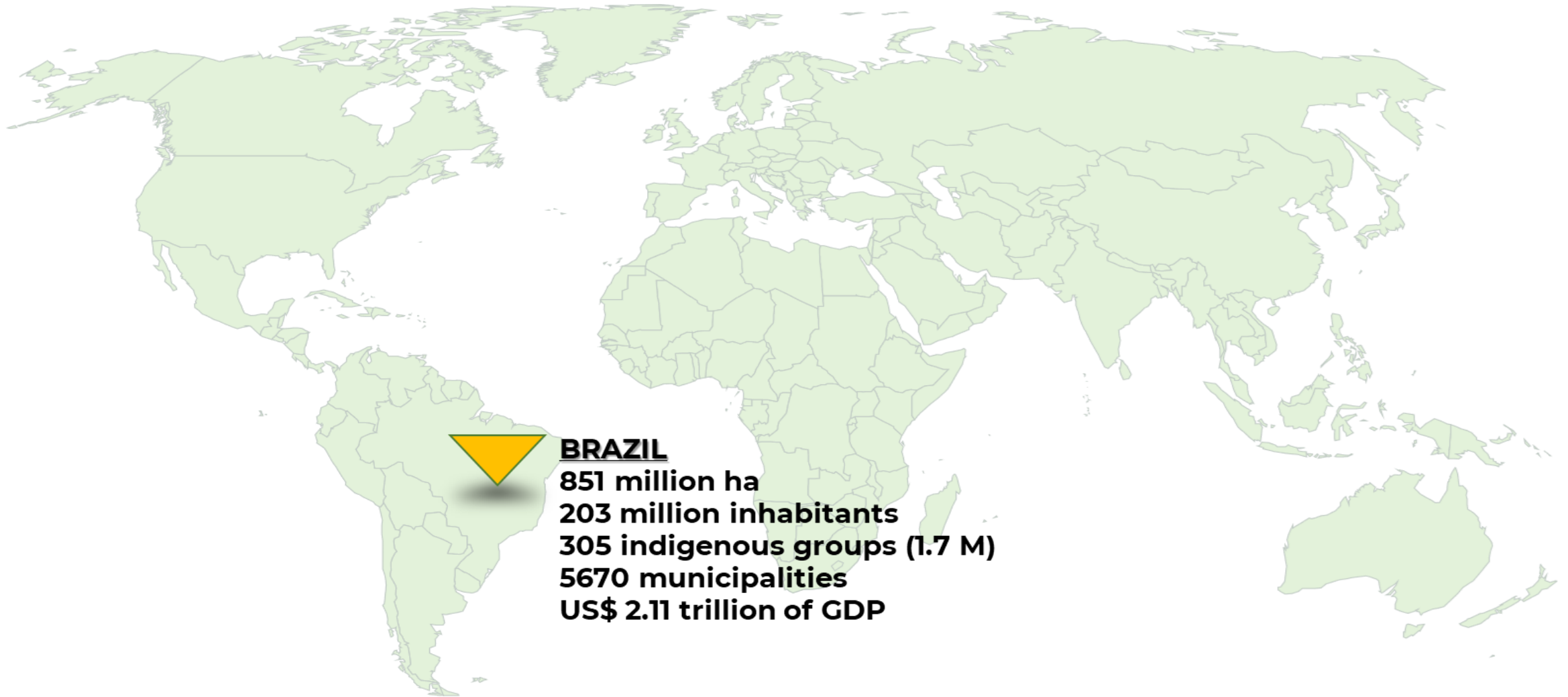

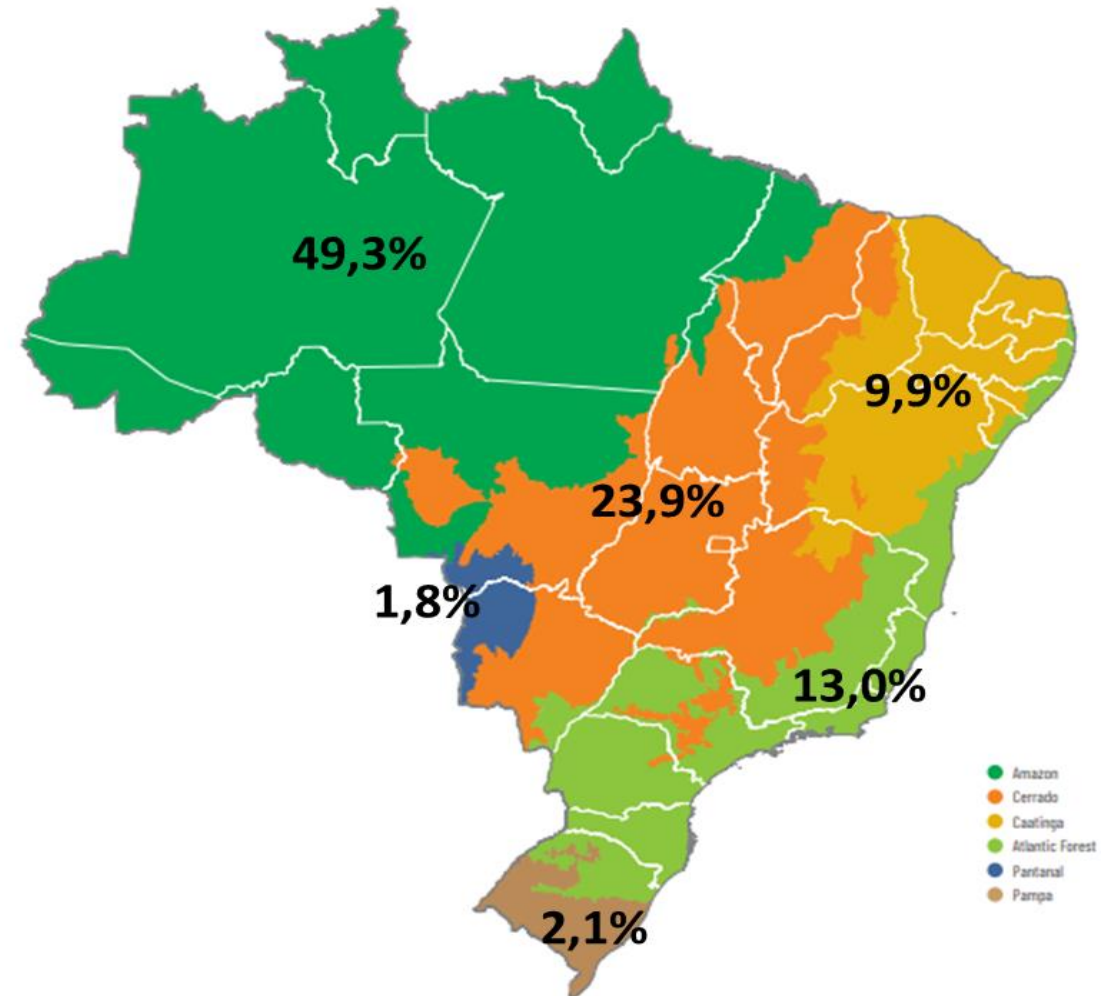

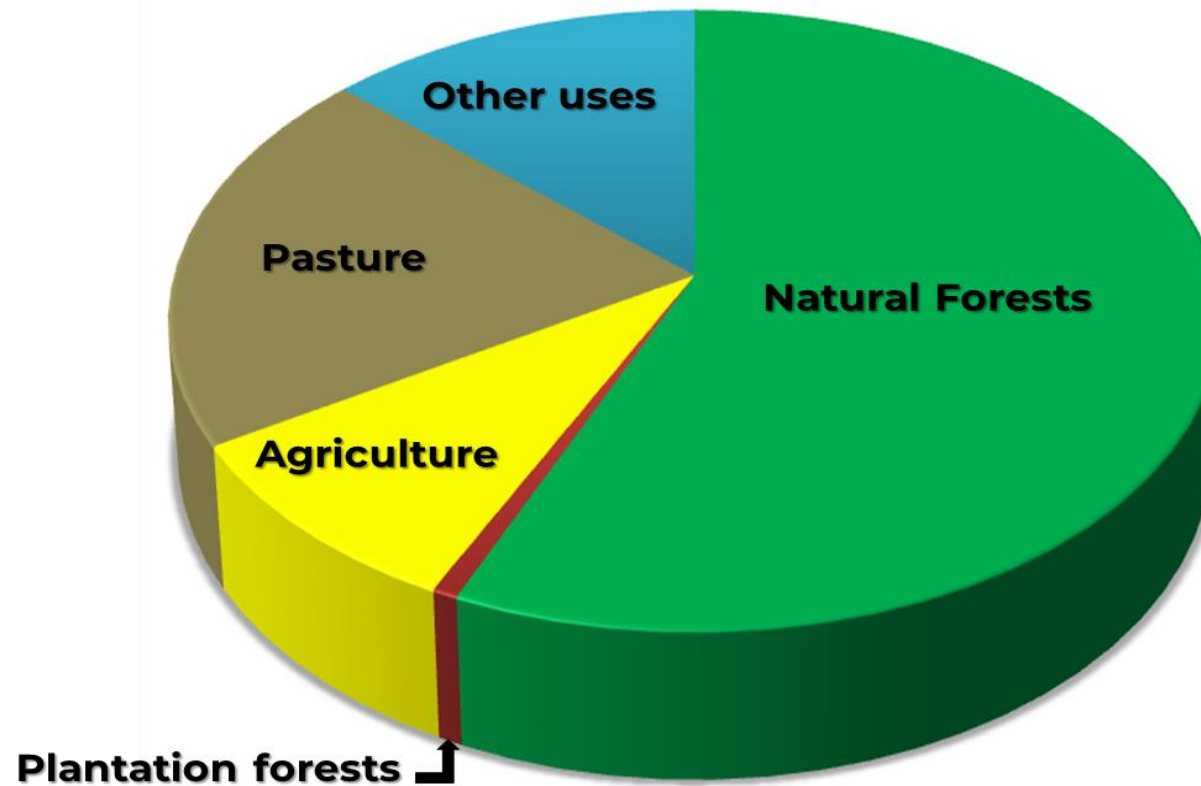
Brazilian Forests Facts

- Brazil has the largest tropical forest area ($\approx \frac{1}{3}$) and holds the largest biodiversity on the planet
- Brazilian forests account for 497 million ha (98% Natural/2% Planted)
- Plantation forests occupy ≈ 10 million ha
- Forest area *per capita* in Brazil is 2.4 ha

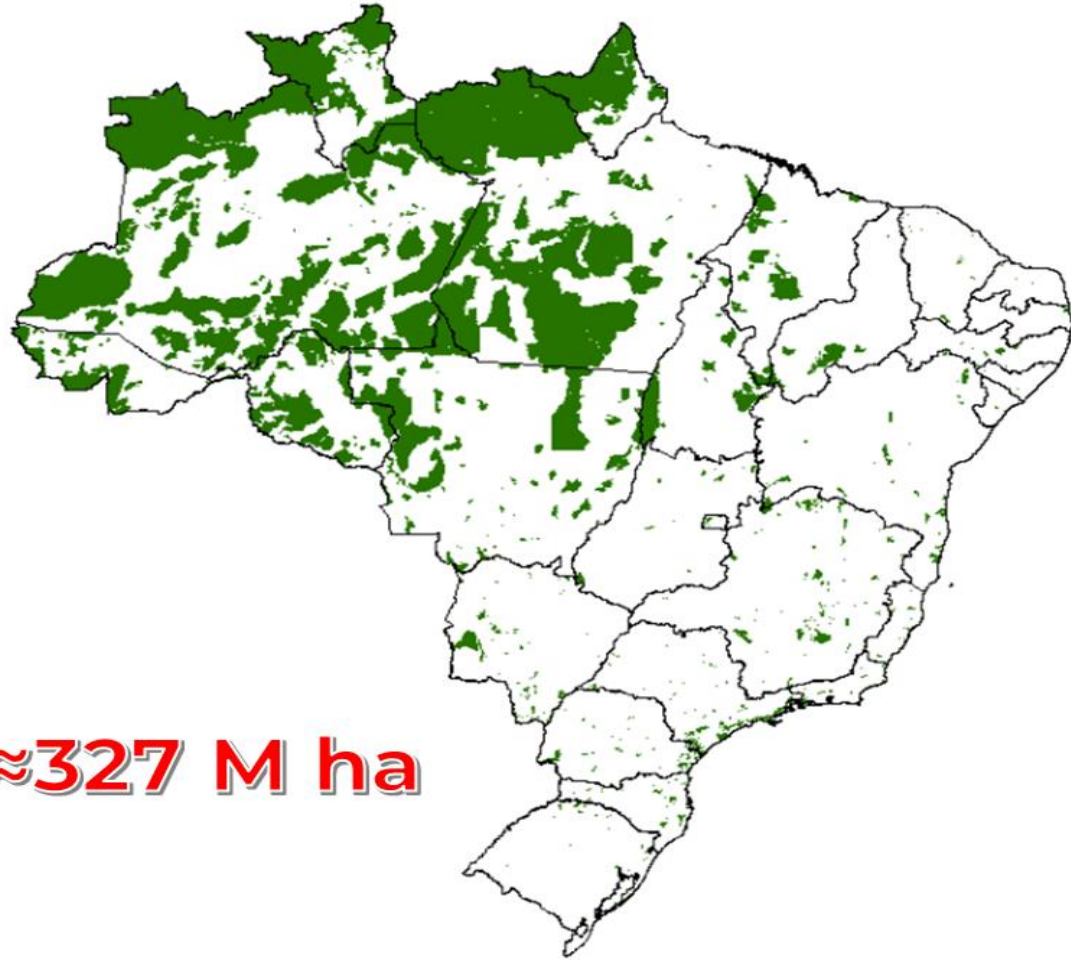


Brazilian Forests Facts

- Forests occupy $\approx 60\%$ of the total area of the country

≈327 M ha

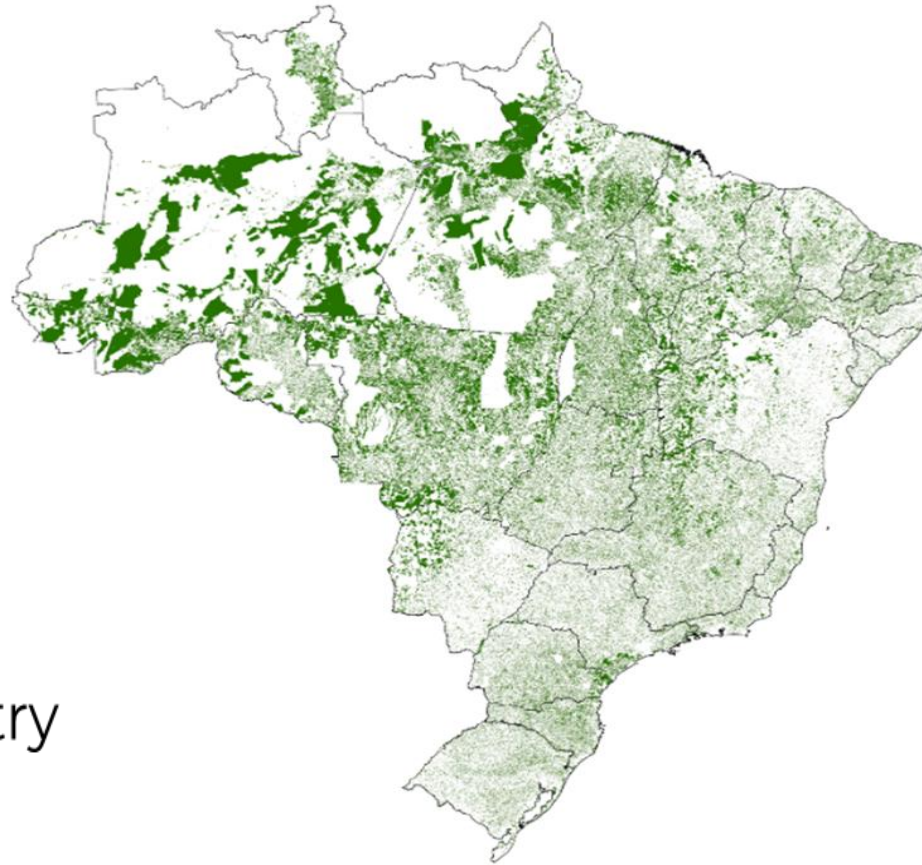


Brazilian forests in the private domain

- Forests occupy $\approx 60\%$ of the total area of the country

Legal Reserve Areas (Sustainable use)

- 80% in the Amazon
- 20% rest of the country



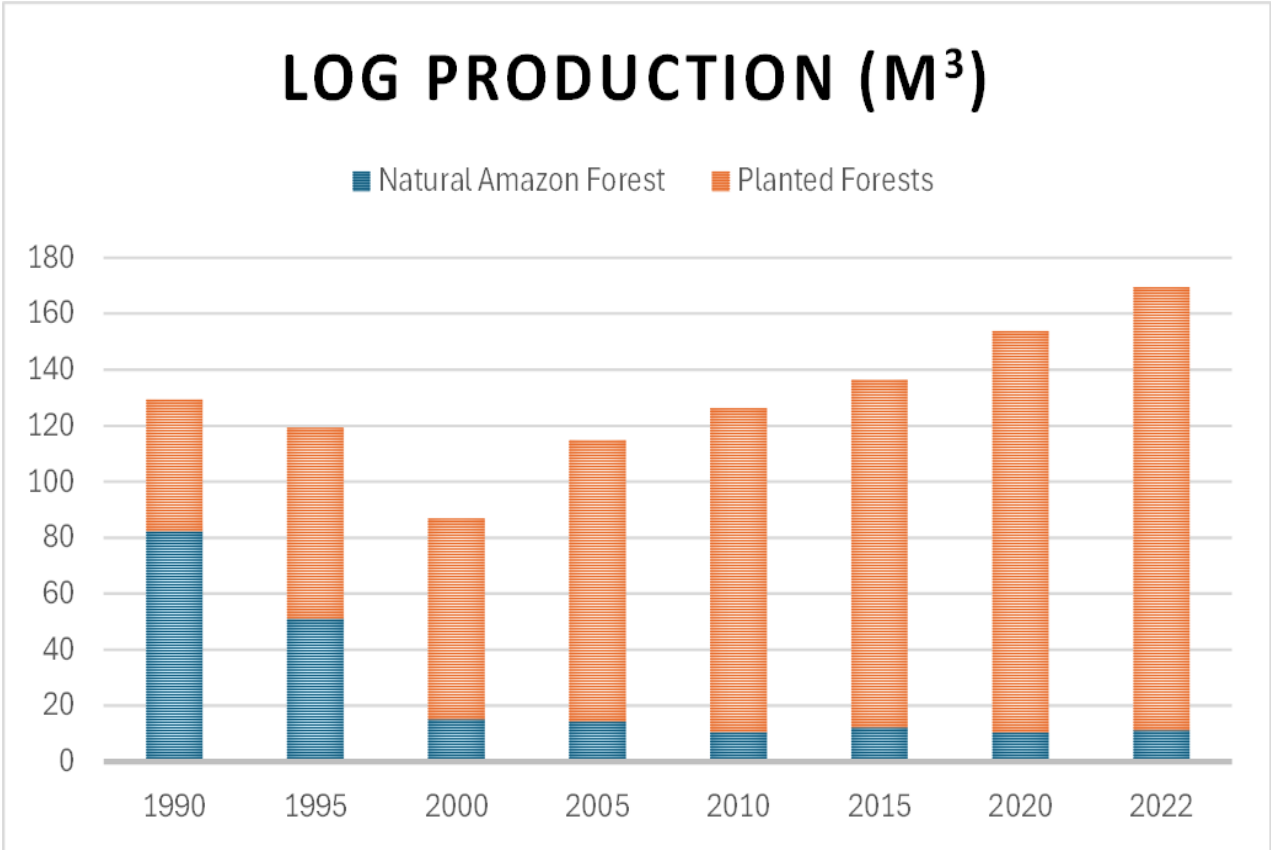
Permanent Preservation Areas (Conservation)

- Along rivers;
- Around watersprings, lakes and lagoons;
- On top of hills;
- On slopes greater than 45°





Log production profile

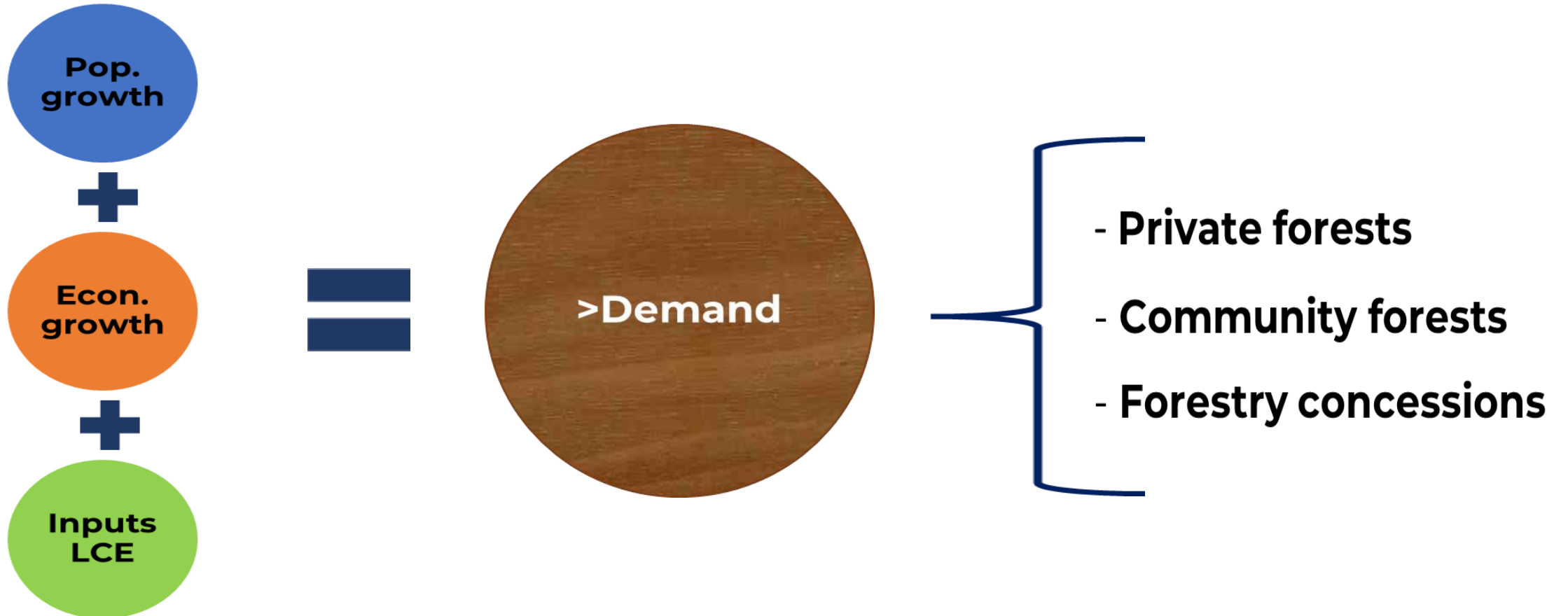

Brazilian Forest Service

- Promote SFM in Public land
 - Manage forest concessions on National Forests and other federal land
 - Support states to manage forest concessions on State Forests and other state land
 - Support community SFM on community public land
 - Value chain
- Promote forest restoration
 - Manage forest restoration concessions on National forests and other federal land
 - Support states to manage forest restoration concessions on State Forests and other state land
 - Support community restoration/ agroforestry
 - Value chain
- Promote environmental regularization on private lands
